SUBJECT: Policy Letter Regarding Areas Open To Fishing

1. This policy identifies areas where fishing is and is not authorized on Robins Air Force Base (RAFB).
2. Questions have arisen over whether some wetland areas of the base should be deemed as not suitable for fishing. Specifically, personnel were observed fishing in spill containment ponds adjacent to the airfield. As the name implies, these ponds were constructed for the purpose of preventing fuel or other potentially hazardous liquids from contaminating the wetlands along the eastern perimeter of the base. They are not managed for fishing.
3. Fishing is authorized in Scout Lake, Luna Lake, and the section of Horse Creek located south of the pipeline bridge and west of Hunting Area 'D.' Persons fishing in Horse Creek should be aware that this creek is located within a hunting area. Fishing in Duck Lake will be authorized following the completion of restoration activities at that site. Contact the Spalding Nature Center (6-4500) for a map of the hunting areas, and for details concerning fishing regulations and permits.
4. Fishing is not authorized in any pond containing a weir, including the three spill containment ponds located along Beale and Borghese Drives. Fishing also is not authorized in the wetlands north of the road which leads to the City of Warner Robins Sewage Treatment Plant, located north of the airfield.
5. This policy will remain in effect until it is superseded by the next revision of RAFB Instruction 32-7064, *Integrated Natural Resources Management*.
